- 2. 168,094 restricted stock units ("RSUs") were granted on September 28, 2018, with 126,070 RSUs vesting prior to the date of this Form 3. The remaining 42,024 RSUs will vest on March 31, 2022. Settlement of vested RSUs will occur within 60 days of the applicable vesting date.
- 3. Each restricted stock unit represents a contingent right to receive one share of the Issuer's common stock.
- 4. 76,127 restricted stock units ("RSUs") were granted on September 28, 2018, with 38,063 RSUs vesting prior to the date of this Form 3. The remaining 38,064 RSUs vest as follows: 19,032 on April 29, 2022 and April 29, 2023. Settlement of vested RSUs will occur within 60 days of the applicable vesting date.
- 5. 174,139 restricted stock units ("RSUs") were granted on April 29, 2019, with 130,604 RSUs vesting prior to the date of this Form 3. The remaining 43,535 RSUs will vest on October 29, 2022. Settlement of vested RSUs will occur within 60 days of the applicable vesting date.
- 6. 219,102 restricted stock units ("RSUs") were granted on March 31, 2020, with 54,775 RSUs vesting prior to the date of this Form 3. The remaining 164,327 RSUs will vest as follows: 54,776 on March 31, 2022 and March 31, 2024, and 54,775 on March 31, 2023. Settlement of vested RSUs will occur within 60 days of the applicable vesting date.
- 7. The restricted stock units ("RSUs") were granted on March 23, 2021, and vest as follows: 18,171 RSUs on March 23, 2022, March 23, 2023, March 23, 2024 and March 23, 2025. Settlement of vested RSUs will occur within 60 days of the applicable vesting date.
- 8. The performance stock units ("PSUs") were granted on April 29, 2019. Each PSU represents a contingent right to receive one share of the Issuer's common stock. The PSUs vest upon the Issuer's common stock achieving a specified price per share.
